RULES & REGULATIONS

CRUELTY TO ANIMALS WILL NOT BE TOLERATED

- **All competitors ride at their own risk.**
- **Indemnity forms** must be completed including PIC Number. **Please download** from our website and bring completed to the show to speed up the entry process
- **No person is allowed in the ring**, with the exception of judges and stewards whilst any competition is taking place; the judge's decision is final
- **All persons assisting** on arena must complete an Indemnity form
- **DRESS:** All competitors must be suitably attired. **Approved Helmets** must be worn whenever on horseback (exercising or competing); except ASH classes
- **No scratching refunds** (unless due to ill health/accident/or at the discretion of the committee)
- **RINGS** will not be held up for competitors. If classes clash competitors must choose, except at the Chief Steward's and/or Judge's discretion
- **RIDING PONY CLASSES** – Must be registered and **MUST** not exceed 14.2hh.
- All horses with a current official SHC or EA measuring certificate must compete in height shown on certificate
- **NOVICE** – Not placed first in an individual hack class or riding class at any Agricultural Show or equivalent show
- Competitors must choose between Hunter and Hack classes; cannot compete in both.
- **NO STALLIONS** will be allowed to compete in open classes; to compete in allocated Stallion classes only, except ANSA and Stock Horse classes
- **STALLIONS** are permitted to enter colour/ breed classes and show jumping events
- **STALLIONS** are to be led or ridden by a person over 17 years with the exception of ASH which is 18 yrs & over
- **The Show Committee** reserves the right to alter the program
- **All official protests must be made in writing within one hour of the completion of judging of the said class and must be accompanied by \$50.00. The fee will be forfeited if the Committee considers the protest frivolous**
- **This show is run** in accordance with the **AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY COUNCIL SHOW RULES**. Hacking & Horse Events run under **SHOW HORSE COUNCIL RULES & GUIDELINES**. Any competitor found to have breached the ASC rules will be investigated by the ASC Disciplinary Committee.

THE FAR SOUTH COAST SHOWJUMPER OF THE YEAR SERIES

Incorporating: The Keith Gordon Senior Showjumper of the Year Award and the Graham Johnson Junior Showjumper of the Year Award. Established in 2009, The Far South Coast Showjumper of the Year Series was initiated to honor the memory of two devoted contributors to the local show circuit and the sport of showjumping. These awards will be presented to the horse and rider combination with the highest point score in showjumping events at shows on the Far South Coast.

RULES

1. Shows eligible for point scoring: The Bega Showjumping Cup, Pambula Show, Candelo, Eurobodalla, Cobargo, Far South Coast National Show, Bega and Bemboka Shows.
2. There is NO minimum amount of shows that contestants are required to participate at to be eligible to score points.
3. EVERY showjumping event consisting of a single horse and rider entry in every ring will be counted towards the point score
4. For the purpose of this point score competition, the junior definition has followed suit of the EA Junior definition. The Junior definition for this competition will be;
☐ Junior definition: All riders up to and including the calendar year in which they turn 18. (i.e. if a participating rider turns 18 in the year the competition is taking place, they are an eligible junior. If they turned 18 the year before, they are a senior).
5. Points will be awarded to the top three placegetters as follows;
1st = 3 points 2nd = 2 points 3rd = 1 point
In the event of equal placings, the horse and rider combinations will take their awarded placing points (ie two in 1st place take 3 points each and 3rd place takes 1 point)
6. Points will be awarded to the rider and horse as a COMBINATION. An individual horse can contest both the senior and junior category if the owner so wishes, as this will not affect the point score in anyway. Contestants must be reminded that the HORSES WELFARE must be paramount at all times.
7. Only the TWO (2) BEST PERFORMANCES of a horse & rider combination PER DAY (if applicable), PER SHOW will count towards the point score.
8. The top three placegetters will receive points in their category regardless of the type of event in which they place. i.e. if a junior rider wins an open event the points will still go towards the Junior point score.

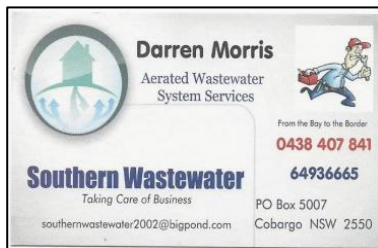
